

The undersigned subscriber to these articles is a natural person, competent to contract, and hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, and under the following articles:

ARTICLE I - NAME

ARTICLE XI - RESTRICTIONS ON SALE OF STOCK



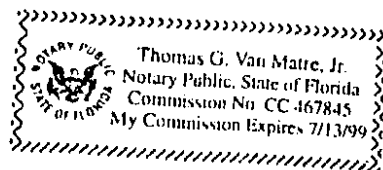


