- By or in the right of this Corporation to procure a b) judgment in its favor by reason of his being or having been a director of officer of this corporation, or by reason of his being or having been a director, officer, employee, or agent of any other corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise which he served at the request of this Corporation, against the reasonable expenses, including attorneys' fees, actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, or in connection with an appeal therein, if such person acted in good faith in the reasonable belief that such action was in the best interests of the Corporation. person shall not be entitled to indemnification in relation to matters as to which such person has been adjudged to have been guilty of negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duty to the Corporation unless and only to the extent that the court, administrative agency, or investigation body before which such action, suit proceeding is held shall determine upon application, that despite the adjudication of liability but in view of all circumstances of the case, such person is fairly and reasonably entitled to indemnification for such expenses which such tribunal shall deem proper.
- 2. Any indemnification under Section (1) shall be made by the Corporation only as authorized in the specific case upon a determination that amounts for which a director of officer seeks indemnification were properly incurred and that such director or officer acted in good faith and in manner he reasonably believed to be in the best interest of the Corporation, and that, with respect
