ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

Pat's Lawn Service Enterprises, Inc.

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

I, the undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby form a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to Chapters 807, Florida Statutes, and execute the following:

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Pat's Lawn Services Enterprises, Inc.

ARTICLE II. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing upon the filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III. GENERAL PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation is to engage in
Lawn care and services
and any lawful business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any time is one hundred (100) shares of common stock, having a par value of one dollar (\$1.00) per share.
