ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

America & International Consultants, Inc.

The undersigned, being an individual, does hereby act as incorporator in adopting the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing a corporation for profit, pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act.

<u>FIRST</u>: The corporate name for the corporation (hereinafter called the "corporation") is America & International Consultants, Inc.

SECOND: The address, wherever located, of the principal office of the corporation, if known, is 2455 S.W. 27th Avenue, Suite 220, Miami, Florida 33145.

THIRD: The mailing address, wherever located, of the corporation is 2455 s.w. 27th Avenue, Suite 220, Miami, Florida 33145.

FOURTH: The number of shares that the corporation is authorized to issue is 500, all of which are with par value of \$1.00 dollar each and are of the same class and are to be Common shares.

SEVENTH: The purposes for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

EIGHTH: The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

NINTH: The corporation shall, to the fullest extent permitted by the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act, as the same may be amended and supplemented, indemnify any and all persons whom it shall have power to indemnify under said provisions from and against any and all of the expenses, liabilities, or other matters referred to in or covered by said provisions, and the indemnification provided for herein shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any Bylaw, vote of shareholders or disinterested directors, or otherwise, both as to action in his official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding such office, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a director, officer, employee, or agent and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors, and administrators of such a person.

TENTH: Whenever the corporation shall be engaged in the business of exploiting natural resources or other wasting assets, distributions may be paid in cash out of depletion or similar reserves at the discretion of the Board of Directors and in conformity with the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act.
