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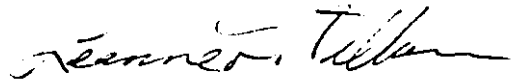

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SUN EMBROIDERY, INC.

I, the undersigned, do hereby subscribe to this Certificate of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida and subject to the following provisions:

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be SUN EMBROIDERY, INC.

ARTICLE II

The Corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

The maximum number of shares of stock which this Corporation shall have outstanding at any time shall be 500 shares of common stock, each share having the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00).

ARTICLE IV

This Corporation shall begin business with a maximum capital of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

ARTICLE V

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI

The principal office of the Corporation shall be located at 11360 N.W. 5th Street, Plantation, Florida, 33355, but offices for the transaction of business may be located wherever the Director may deem necessary of expedient.

ARTICLE VII

The business of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors who need not be stockholders of the Corporation. The number of directors, not less than one, shall be fixed by resolution of the stockholders at any regular or special meeting, subject to the manner of holding such meetings prescribed by the by-laws.

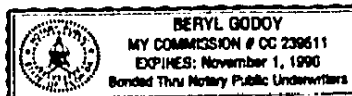
