ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
REID ENDOCRINE ASSOCIATES, P.A.

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The undersigned, desiring to organize a professional service corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, hereby certifies as follows:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation is REID ENDOCRINE ASSOCIATES, P.A. and its address is 555 Biltmore Way, Suite 205, Coral Gables, Florida 33134.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

The general nature of the professional services to be rendered by this professional service corporation shall be as follows, to-wit:

- (a) To engage in every phase and aspect of the business of rendering the same professional services to the public that a physician, duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida, is authorized to render, but such professional services shall be rendered only through officers, employees, and agents who are duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida to practice therein.
- (b) To buy, sell, deal in and exchange shares of its own capital stock, except that the corporation shall not issue any of its capital stock to anyone other than an individual who is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render professional medical services within the State of Florida. No shareholder of the corporation shall enter into a voting trust agreement or any other type of agreement vesting another person with the authority to exercise the voting power of any or all of his stock.
- (c) To invest the funds of the corporation in real estate, mortgages, stock, bonds, or any other type

of investment, and to own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

- (d) To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attaining of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the purposes enumerated in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereof, necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation, and, in general, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, to carry on any lawful pursuit necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of the purpose or the attainment of the objects or the furtherance of such purposes or objects of the corporation.
- (e) Without limiting the generality of any of the foregoing language, the corporation shall have all of the powers which are now or which may hereafter be conferred upon professional service corporations by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

Stock

The maximum number of shares of stock which the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is Seventy-Five Hundred (7,500) Shares of Common Stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE IV

Existence

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V

Initial Registered Office and Agent

The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation is Edward L. Reid, II, M.D. and the street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 555 Biltmore Way, Suite 205, Coral Gables, Florida 33134.

ARTICLE VI

Stock Transferability

No Shareholder of the corporation may sell or transfer his shares in the corporation except to another individual who is eligible to be a Shareholder of a professional service corporation within the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VII

Stock Ownership

The Board of Directors shall require any Officer, Shareholder, agent, or employee of the corporation, who has been rendering professional medical services to the public and who becomes legally disqualified to render such professional medical services within the State of Florida, or who is elected to a public office or accepts employment that, pursuant to existing law, places restrictions or limitations upon his continuing to render such professional medical services, to sever all employment with, and financial interest in, the corporation forthwith.

ARTICLE VIII

Directors

The corporation shall have one (1) Director initially. The number of Directors may be increased or diminished, from time to time, by Bylaws adopted by the Shareholders, but shall never be less than one (1).

ARTICLE IX

Initial Directors
