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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned natural persons of legal age, acting as incorporators under the provisions of Florida Statutes, Chapter 607, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

<u>NAME</u>

The name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II

Purpose

The corporation may engage or transact in any or all lawful sales or maintenance activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida or any other state, county, territory or nation.

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ARTICLE III

Stock Clause

The aggregate number of shares of stock which this corporation shall have authority to issue shall be 100 shares of common stock (each with a par value of \$1.00)

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

Informal Shareholder Action

The holders of not less than a majority of the issued and outstanding shares of the voting stock of the corporation may act by written agreement without a meeting, as provided in Florida Statutes 607,394 and the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

Lundamental Changes

The affirmative vote of holders of the majority of the outstanding shares of all classes of stock entitled to vote shall be necessary for the following corporate action

- a. Amendment, alteration, change or repeal of any provision of the Articles of Incorporation.
- b. Reorganization, merger or consolidation of the corporation.
- c. Sale, lease or exchange of the major portion of the property or assets of the corporation,
- d. Dissolution of the corporation,

ARTICLE VII

Directors

- A. The business of the corporation shall be managed initially by a board of one (1) director(s). The number of directors may be, as provided in the bylaws, increased or decreased, but shall never be less than one (1) director(s).
- B. The entire Boars' of Directors, or any individual director, may be removed from office without assignment of cause by affirmative vote of 100% of the outstanding shares of all classes of stock entitled to vote. Directors who are not stockholders may be removed for cause by a majority vote of all classes of stock entitled to vote. 
