ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COMPUSPORT OF MIAMI, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of CompuSPORT of Miami, Inc., under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is:

ARTICLE III. COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the corporation will commence on August 22, 1995.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

The corporation is organized to perform any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida.

ARTICLE V. AUTHORIZED SHARES

The maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is 10,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$.01 per share.

bylaw adopted by the shareholders if the shareholders specifically provide that the bylaw is not subject to amendment or repeal by the directors.
