ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

BISCAYNE CAR AND TRUCK RENTAL, INC.

We, the undersigned, being the incorporators of Biscayne Car and Truck Rental, Inc., do hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, immunities and liabilities of incorporating for profit.

ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation shall be:
