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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SAN PABLO COURT, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE_I

Name, Location and Mailing Address of Principal Office

The name of the corporation is San Pablo Court, Inc. The principal office and mailing address of this corporation is 7751 Belfort Parkway, Suite 350, Jacksonville, Fl. 32256.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all business permitted under the laws of the United States or the State of Florida.
