

I, the undersigned, being the President of UNITED LABOR OF AMERICA, INC., a Florida Corporation, do hereby CERTIFY that the following Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation was duly adopted by unanimous vote of all of the Directors and all of the Shareholders, at a meeting duly held on the 1st day of May, 1998.

A M E N D M E N T

ARTICLE III is hereby amended to hereafter read as follows:

ARTICLE III. Purpose.

The general purposes for which the corporation is are the following:

A. To engage in and transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act. No other purpose limits this general purpose in any way.

B. To do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them, including but not limited to, the operation as an insurance agency and all other acts germane to the insurance industry in which it is authorized to do so be statute.

In all other respects, the Articles of Incorporation shall remain as they were prior to this Amendment being adopted.
