The undersigned, for the purpose of forming and organizing a corporation for profit under the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the corporation is JAMES ROBERT STRAUB, P. A.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are to engage in the business of real estate sales as a licensed real estate professional as permitted by Florida law.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPA L OFFICE

The principal place of business and the mailing address of the corporation shall be 145 Da Vinci Drive, Nokomis, Florida, 34275.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The corporation is authorized to issue One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00). Each share of common stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one vote on each matter considered at any stockholder's meeting. Said share shall be paid for in lawful money of the United States of America or in property, labor or services rendered at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors and said share shall be deemed fully paid and nonassessable. The Corporation elects to have preemptive rights.

ARTICLE V - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE VI - SHAREHOLDER VOTING REQUIREMENTS

When a quorum exists at any meeting of the Shareholders, action on a matter, other than the election of Directors, is approved if the votes east by the holders of not less than a majority of the shares represented at such meeting, and entitled to vote on the subject matter favor the action.
