CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

NORTHSIDE MOWER AND SMALL ENGINE REPAIR, INC.

We, the undersigned, hereby execute this document for the purpose of doing business as a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liability, rights and privileges and immunities of a corporation for profit.

ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation shall be: Northside Mower and Small Engine Repair, Inc.

ARTICLE II

GENERAL NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business and the objects and the purposes proposed to be transacted and carried on, are to be any and all things hereinafter mentioned, as freely and the same extent as natural persons might or could do, viz;

(a) To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of operating small engine repair services and repair services for but not limited to contractual warranty repairs, two and four cycle engines, both gas and electric, riding mowers, push mowers, chain saws, blowers, pumps, line trimmers, hedge trimmers, edgers, electric motors, inboard and outboard marine motors, and

for such items which are manually operated without motors, go carts and golf carts, sharpening of blades for this equipment, locksmith services and all such services in connection therewith, on a retail basis.

(b) To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of selling parts and supplies for but not limited to two and four cycle engines, riding mowers, push mowers, chain saws, blowers, pumps, line trimmers, hedge trimmers, edgers, electric motors, inboard and outboard marine motors, and for such items which are manually operated without motors, go carts and golf carts, and all such services in connection therewith, on a retail basis.

(c) To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of selling, lawn and garden supplies, animal feeds, small tools, tires, garden equipment, generators, two and four cycle engines, inboard and outboard marine motors, riding mowers, push mowers, chain saws, blowers, pumps, line trimmers, hedge Trimmers, edgers, electric motors and for such items which are manually operated without motors, go carts and golf carts, both new and used, and all such services in connection therewith, on a retail basis.

(d) To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of renting garden equipment, generators, two and four cycle engines, inboard and outboard marine motors, riding mowers, push mowers, chain saws, blowers, pumps, line trimmers, hedge trimmers, edgers, go carts and golf carts, electric motors and for such items which are manually operated without motors.

(e) To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of selling equipment or commodities connected to or supporting the services listed in (a) (b) (c) and (d).

(f) To acquire, own, improve, lease, operate, maintain, mortgage, sell or exchange or otherwise dispose of or acquire real and personal property, including stock in any other corporation, mortgages, bonds, debentures, and other securities, merchandise, book debts and claims, trade marks, trade names, patent and patent rights and copyrights.

(g) To borrow money for its corporate purposes and to make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures, other obligations, from time to time, for the purpose of purchasing property, or for any purpose in or about the business of the company, and if deemed proper to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage pledge, deed of trust, or otherwise.

(h) To sell, improve, manage, develop, lease, mortgage, dispose of, or otherwise turn to account or deal with all or any part of the property of the company.

(i) To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, and to every other act or thing incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected

with the aforesaid business or powers, or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

ARTICLE III  
CAPITAL STOCK

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be divided into one hundred (100) shares of common stock, at a par value of Fifty (\$50.00) dollars per share, all of said stock shall be payable in cash, property, labor or services, as fixed by the Board of Directors of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The amount of capital with which this corporation shall commence business shall be Five Thousand (\$5000.00) dollars.

ARTICLE V

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved according by law.

ARTICLE VI

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The registered office of said corporation shall be 3320 North Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida and its initial registered agent shall be: Robert Yakin

The number of directors of this corporation shall not be less than two nor more than five.

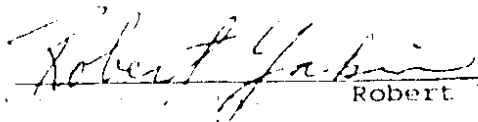
