ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CHAMPION GROUNDS MAINTENANCE, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the States of Florida, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:

Champion Grounds Maintenance, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The corporation may engage in any activity or business as permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida but only through its officers, employees, and agents who are duly licensed or authorized to render such business.

ARTICLE IV

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be TEN THOUSAND SHARES (10,000) at One Dollar (5:.00) par value per share. Such stock shall be non-assessable to be held, sold and paid for at such time and in such manner as the Board of Directors may, from time to time, determine. All of the capital stock shall be common stock.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall commence business five (5) business days prior to the filing with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE YI

The principal place for the transaction of its business shall be 450 42nd Avenue NE. St. Petersburg, Florida 33703. That said corporation shall have the right and authority to do business at such other place or places within or without the State of Florida, as the corporation may by resolution designate.
