To Whom It May Concern,

I have just received the 2nd Notice for filing the 1998 Profit Corporations Annual Report for one of our corporations, John's Construction Of Franklin County, inc. could not find any records of filing or writing a check. It took me several days to locate the form and it had not been filed. I called your office and explained my problem to someone there. She suggested that I send in the form with the filing fee and a letter explaining why I had not filed it. So enclosed you will find the form and a check for the filing fee. She said that if you did not reverse the penalty after reviewing my letter of explanation that this office would contact me as to what penalties I might owe.

In checking for John's Construction I discovered that I had not filed for Linda's Trading Post either the explanation below applies to both corporations.

We are a very small corporation and up until the middle of Sept., 97 there was 2 employees in the office. Me and one part-time person that helped with filing, payroll and answering the phones. The middle of September she gave her notice to go work for the Dept. of Corrections. This same person also worked for our other Crop., Linda's Trading Post. as a store clerk in our retail souvenir shop. With Christmas coming up, which is always a busy time in the retail store and we do UPS shipping for this area, it left me in bad shape. I hired another women but couldn't find anyone experienced in UPS and making T-shirts. This person was suppose to be experienced as a store clerk. She was not and made mistake after mistake. She left the first week in Dec. This left me in even worst shape. As I had to cover both businesses alone. I hired a man that again was suppose to have experience as a store clerk, he was no better and had problems with UPS and doing the T-shirts. He was not much better as a store clerk, having problems with the cash register, making change, doing the normal store duties. He stayed and was somewhat a help. In my personal life at that same time I had just lost a brother-in-law, a brother, and a Father-inlaw. My Father-in- law was ill for some time before he passed away and we had to help with him. My mother also had a terminal decease through this and I had to take care of her. Her illness progressed to a point where she had to move in my house and had to have total help in her everyday life. Not only was it physically trying but to try to run two businesses and take care of a dying parent and keep up normal household and just normal personal activities was very stressful. She passed away this year, I then had to deal with all funeral arrangements and settling of her estate. Since she did not leave a will all that just added to the confusion and stress. In this time we lost 3 of my husbands uncles and I lost 4 uncles. It seems that I have lost almost my entire family in about 12 months. Somehow in all the confusion the forms that I had to send in got misplaced, they were never filed and I was -not aware of this. We try to file everything on time and do all our taxes on time.

This year was the first time in over 10 years that I had to file an extension on our income taxes. I do hope that this will be reason enough to reverse the penalties. It will sure be a hardship on both corporations if we must pay penalties on both corporations.

Please advise of your décision as soon as possible. I am sending the form and a check for the filing fee with this letter.
