
Dear Sir or Madam:

As the accountant for the above-named corporations I have been asked to transmit to you Corporation Applications for Reinstatement. Also enclosed is my client's check in the amount of \$750 to cover the annual report fee and the corporate supplemental fee (\$300 for Emerson MOB, Inc. and \$450 for Medical Partners Equities, Inc.).

The owner of these corporations is Brett J. Lewis. Mr. Lewis owns and operates more than five corporations and partnerships in Jacksonville. The corporations and partnerships were operated out of business premises on Emerson Expressway in Jacksonville, Florida for several years. In 1998 the building was sold and Mr. Lewis began operating the businesses out of his home at 1802 Largo Road in Jacksonville. Subsequently, Mr. Lewis became involved in a lawsuit with the buyer of the building. Unfortunately, the Uniform Business Reports for both of these corporations were never received. It is believed that the buyer of the building purposely destroyed these forms when they were sent to the old address.

The purpose of this letter is to transmit to you the reinstatement forms for these corporations and to request that you abate the \$600 reinstatement penalties. If you have any questions or require any additional information in order to consider the abatement of penalties, please contact me.
