FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

This cause came before the court for final hearing upon the petition for dissolution of marriage filed by the Husband. The Court having heard the testimony and evidence presented, and having been otherwise fully advised in the premises, does hereby make the following FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action.

2. At least one party has been a resident of the State of Florida for more than six months immediately before filing the Petition.

3. On May 13, 1999, the parties entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement which is acceptable to both parties.

4. The marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken.

THEREFORE it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The marriage between the parties is dissolved and the parties are restored to the status of being single.

2. The Marital Settlement Agreement, which has been introduced as an exhibit in this suit, is ratified and incorporated into this judgment, and the parties are directed to comply with all of its provisions.

3. The Wife is hereby restored to her former name and shall henceforth be known as CYNTHIA MARIE GRIFFIN.

4. The court specifically reserves jurisdiction to enforce the terms and conditions of this final judgment and marital settlement agreement.
