## Articles of Incorporation

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of

SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

## Lightsystems Technologies, Corp.

Article 1 - Name. The name of the corporation shall be Lightsystems Technologies Corp.

Article 2 - Duration. This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State, State of Florida.

Article 3 - Purpose. This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting business as a manufacturer, sales and marketing organization, to buy, sell, distribute, job, be a franchise dealer or licensee, import, export and otherwise deal in lights and lighting fixtures and accessories of every kind and description and other related and unrelated products at wholesale and at retail and as principal and agent. To develop, experiment with, conduct research on, manufacture, produce, assemble, buy, rent or otherwise acquire, hold, own, operate, use, install, equip, replace, maintain, service, process, reprocess, repair, remodel, recondition, import, export, sell, lease, market, distribute, transport or otherwise dispose of and generally to deal in and with, as contractor, subcontractor, principal, agent, commission merchant, recondition, broker, factor, or any combination of the foregoing, and at wholesale or retail, or both, any and all kinds of lighting fixtures and accessories and all allied apparatus, systems, parts, supplies, tools, implements, raw materials, natural products, manufactured articles and products, and goods, wares, merchandise and tangible property of every kind, used, or capable of being used, for any purpose whatever.

To patent, manufacture, buy, sell, repair, export and import, and generally deal in lamps and all the parts thereof in which kerosene or other fluid is burned, electric lamps and fixtures and all the parts thereof, gas lamps, mantels and fixtures and all the parts thereof, candelabra, chandeliers, candle sticks and holders, lanterns of all kinds, whether oil, gas or electric, and any and all other means, appliances, devices or machines for supplying artificial light.

To acquire by purchase, subscription, underwriting or otherwise, and to own, hold for investment, or otherwise, and to use, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange or otherwise dispose of, real and personal property of every sort and description and wheresoever situated, including shares of stock, bonds, debentures, notes, scrip, securities, evidences of indebtedness, contracts or obligations of any corporation or association, whether domestic or foreign, or of any firm or individual, or of the Unites States, or any state, territory or dependency of the United States or any foreign country, or any municipality or local authority within or without the United States, and also to issue in exchange therefor, stocks, bonds or other securities or evidences of indebtedness of this corporation and, while the owner or holder of any such property, to receive, collect and dispose of the interest, dividends and income on, or from such property, and to possess and exercise in respect thereto, all rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including all voting powers thereon.

To construct, build, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, equip, hold, own, improve, develop, manage, maintain, control, operate, lease, mortgage, create liens upon, sell, convey or otherwise dispose of and turn to account, any and all plants, machinery, works, implements and things or property, real and personal, of every kind and description, incidental to, connected with, or suitable, necessary or convenient for any of the purposes enumerated herein, including all or any part or parts of the properties, assets, business and good will of any persons, firms, associations or corporations.

To apply for and receive patents, trademarks, service marks and/or copyrights pertaining to the products, services and business of the corporation.

The powers, rights and privileges provided in this certificate are not to be deemed to be in limitation of similar, other or additional powers, rights and privileges, granted or permitted to a corporation by the Florida Statutes, it being intended that this corporation shall have all the rights, powers and privileges granted or permitted to corporations by said statutes.

To be even more specific, this corporation shall be empowered to transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be formed under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, as it now may exist, or may later be amended.

- Article 4 Stock. This corporation is authorized to issue 5,000 shares of no-par value common stock, hereinafter designated as the "common shares".
- Article 5 Pre-Emptive Rights. Every shareholder, upon the sale of any stock of this corporation for cash, shall have the right to purchase his or her pro-rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.
