ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

JIM YANCEY & COMPANY

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Active do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE Name

The name of the corporation is Jim Yancey & Company.

ARTICLE TWO Corporate Duration

This corporation shall have perpetual existence. The date and time of the commencement of corporate existence is at the time of filing the Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State.

ARTICLE THREE Purpose

The general purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
