ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

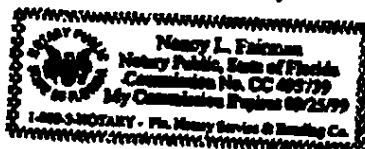
