ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

RAYMOND OAKS HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be:
RAYMOND OAKS HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.,

SECRETARY OF STATE SECRETARY OF STATE

a non-profit corporation with its place of business at 1220 Windsor Avenue, Longwood, Florida 32750.

ARTICLE II

The general nature, purposes and objectives for which this Corporation is formed shall be:

- (a) To organize the residents and property owners of RAYMOND OAKS, a subdivision according to the plat thereof, as filed in the public records of Seminole County, Florida.
- (b) To establish a community association whose purpose shall be to maintain and operate the common areas of and the private street located in RAYMOND OAKS, other than Tract B of such RAYMOND OAKS.
- (c) To further and promote by all proper and legitimate agencies and means the activities required to maintain common areas and private roadway areas for the use of the members of the Raymond Oaks Homeowners' Association, Inc. and their guests and invitees.
- (d) To provide for access by providers of essential public services, including, but not limited to, electrical service, water distribution service, wastewater collection service, if any, stormwater management services, cable television services, fire and emergency services, and related services.

- (e) To operate, maintain and manage the surface water and stormwater systems constructed for RAYMOND OAKS in a manner consistent with:
 - the conditions set forth in and the requirements of the St. Johns Water Management District permit no. 40-117-0339A-ERP and
 - 2) the rules of the St. Johns Water Management District.
- (f) To assist in the enforcement of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Reservations of RAYMOND OAKS which relate to the surface water and stormwater management systems.
- (g) To levy and collect assessments from members of the Corporation who are owners of Lots in RAYMOND OAKS that are reasonably adequate to cover the costs of maintenance and operation of the surface and stormwater management system at RAYMOND OAKS.

ARTICLE III

The membership shall consist of those persons who purchase lots or homes which are built upon lots in RAYMOND OAKS, Seminole County, Florida, and for those persons who own any of the Tracts located within RAYMOND OAKS. There shall be only one membership per lot or home that is purchased and one membership per Tract, but persons may share a single membership.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual unless and until dissolved as it is now or may be hereafter provided by law. The corporation's existence shall commence upon the filing of these articles of incorporation with the Florida Department of State in Tallahassee, Florida.

ARTICLE V

This Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors no less than three nor more than nine who need not be members of the Association who shall initially be appointed by the Developer of Raymond Oaks and, in subsequent years shall be elected as provided in the Bylaws. The names and street addresses of the members of the first Board of Directors who shall hold office for the first year of existence of the Corporation or until their successors are elected or appointed and have qualified are:

ARTICLE VII

Dale S. Jones, located at 1220 Windsor Avenue, Longwood, Florida 32750, has been named as the Corporation's Agent to accept service of process within this 3tate. Said Agent has accepted the request to act in this capacity.

ARTICLE VIII

In the event of termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the Association, the responsibility for the operation and

maintenance of the surface water and stormwater management systems shall be transferred to and accepted by an entity which would comply with Rule 40C-42.07, Florida Administrative Code, and such successor entity shall submit itself for approval and be approved by the St. Johns Water Management District prior to the winding up of the affairs of the Corporation and to the extent permitted by law, prior to the termination, dissolution or liquidation of the Corporation, as the case may be.

ARTICLE IX

In the event of termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the Association or in the event of a deadlock, or a failure to operate the surface water or stormwater management systems or any other failure to act by the Corporation caused by nonaction of its members, the Corporation, a member of the Corporation, an officer of the Corporation, or a Director of the Corporation or the St. Johns Water Management District shall be entitled to request that a receiver be appointed by a court of competent jurisdiction, to take over the operation of the Corporation to comply with the stormwater and surface water management obligations of the Corporation by virtue of the permit and administrative rules set forth above. The court shall have the right to impose upon members of the Corporation sufficient additional assessments to pay compensation to the receiver, to pay for any legal costs involved in the receivership and to pay the costs associated with the

operation of or any transfer of surface water or stormwater obligations to other entities.
