# Articles of Incorporation of The Florida Women's Legislative Caucus Educational Foundation, Inc.

The undersigned persons, acting as incorporators of a corporation not for profit under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

# Article III Purpose of Corporation

The object and purpose of this corporation shall be as follows:

- (a) The activities of this corporation are such as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, making distributions to organizations which qualify as tax exempt organizations under the Code.
- (b) To further and aid the educational endeavors and programs of the Florida Women's Legislative Caucus by advancing women's issues and providing aid to aspiring women leaders through paid internships.
- (c) To conduct any and all lawful not for profit business and/or activities which corporations may do which are incorporated under Florida Law.

### Article IV Membership

The membership of the Florida Women's Legislative Caucus shall be open to any and all duly elected women members of the Florida House of Representatives

and of the Florida Senate for the duration of their term in office regardless of party affiliation.

The members of this corporation shall have no right, title, or interest whatsoever in its income, property, or assets, nor shall any portion of such income, property, or assets be distributed to any member on the dissolution or winding up of this corporation. Members of this corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities, or obligations of the corporation, and shall not be subject to any assessments.

#### Article VI Officers

The officers of the corporation shall be a President, one or more Vice Presidents, Treasurer, Secretary, and such other officers as may be provided in the Bylaws. #### Article VII Directors

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of five (5) members initially. The number may be increased or decreased from time to time pursuant to the provisions of the Bylaws of the corporation, but shall never be less than three.

The members of the Board of Directors shall be members of the corporation,

and shall be elected and appointed in accordance with the provisions contained thereafter in the Bylaws.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all the members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote of the directors. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law that relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the Board of Directors without meeting and that the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of this corporation authorize the directors to act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

#### Article VIII Bylaws

The Board of Directors of the corporation may provide such Bylaws for the conduct of its meeting and the carrying out its purpose as they may deem necessary from time to time. The initial Bylaws will be adopted upon approval of three-fourths of the Board of Directors.

Subject to the limitations contained in the Bylaws and any limitation set forth in the Not For Profit Corporation Act of Florida described above, concerning

corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members of the corporation, the Bylaws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to, or new Bylaws may be adopted, either by a resolution of the Board of Directors or by following the procedure set forth therefor in the Bylaws.

#### Article IX Amendments

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at a special meeting of the membership called for that purpose by two-thirds vote of those present and voting. Amendments may also be made at a regular meeting of the membership on notice given by the Bylaws of intention to submit such amendment.

### Article X Registered Agent

#### Article XI Special Provisions

The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

Upon dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a not for profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
