## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KOREAN CULTURAL FOUNDATION OF GREATER MIAMI, INC.

(A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT)

We, the undersigned, have associated ourselves as a body corporate with all the rights and privileges granted by the laws of the State of Florida and do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be KOREAN CULTURAL FOUNDATION OF GREATER MIAMI, INC.

### ARTICLE II PURPOSE

- (A) The purposes of Korean Cultural Foundation of Greater Miami, Inc. (the Corporation) are:
- 1. To preserve the cultural heritage and identity of Korean-American community.
- 2. To promote, and assist Korean cultural activities among younger generation of Korean-Americans in the South Florida region.
- 3. To introduce Korean culture within the communities of South Florida region by participating cultural events and activities of the region, or to ptopagate Korean culture by hosting cultural events.
- (B) The Corporation in its activities shall be non-profit, non-partisan, non-sectarian, and shall take no part in or lend its support or endorsement of any candidate for public offices.
- (C) The purpose for which this corporation is formed are purely civic, charitable, educational, and for the express purposes herein set out, and not for financial gain, and no financial gain shall ever accrue to any member of this Corporation by reason of his being a member thereof.

### ARTICLE III TERM OF EXISTENCE AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS ON DISSOLUTION

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law.

In the event of dissolution of the Corporation, all assets of the Corporation shall be transferred to an organization with similar purposes and no part thereof shall be distributed to the members of the Corporation.

### ARTICLE IV INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial principal office of the Corporation shall be at 1550 Madruga Avenue, Suite 415, Coral Gables, Florida 33146.

#### ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

Any person who has bona fide interest in Korean culture may become a member of the Corporation in accordance with the procedure to be set by the bylaws.

#### ARTICLE VI BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The number of the trustees of the Corporation, which shall not be less than three, shall be stated in the bylaws. The board of trustees shall have the authority to review the plan for the Corporation activities, to approve the Corporation budget, to executive committee to which the board of trustee can delegate its duty and authority. The term of the office, manner of his or her election or appointment, and scope of its authority shall be determined by the bylaws of the Corporation. The bylaws of the Corporation shall be adopted, amended and repealed by the board of trustees.

### ARTICLE VII EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF TRUSTEES

The executive committee of trustees shall consist of trustees not more than five. The executive committee shall report to the board of trustees on regular basis, and shall represent the board of trustees when the board of trustees is adjourned. The officers of the Corporation can attend the executive committee meeting, but have no voting right.

### ARTICLE VIII OFFICERS

The Corporation shall have a President, Vice Presidents of which number will be determined by the bylaws, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. Said officers with the exception of the President shall be appointed by the president. The president shall be elected by the board of trustees of the Corporation for the term of two years. There is no limitation on how many terms, consecutively or otherwise, an officer can serve in one or more capacities.

### ARTICLE IX AMENDMENT

The board of trustees shall have power and authority to adopt, amend, or repeal these Articles and the bylaws as they deem it necessary for the objective, policy, and regulation of the affairs of this Corporation.
