These Articles of Incorporation are executed to establish a Corporation under the laws of Florids.

ARTICLE 1 - CORPORATE NAME AND ADDRESS: The Name and Address of this Corporation:

ARTICLE 3 - AUTRORIZED SHARKS (Maximum Number and Par Value Per Share);

One Thousand (1000) Shares at One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.
