The undersigned, acting as Incorporator (s) to form a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

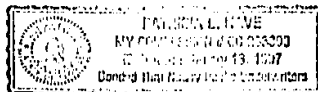
