The undersigned, acting as sole incorporator, adopts these Articles of Indoporation and ORIDA forms a profit corporation (the "Corporation") under the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Act"), as follows:

I. Name

The name of the Corporation is Total Education International, Inc.

II. Term of Existence
