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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is INVESTORS' RIGHTS, INC.

and said purchase shall be on such basis and for such consideration and the issuance of so much of the capital stock as the Directors of the company may decide.

ARTICLE V

The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business shall not be less than Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VI

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 6971 North Federal Highway, Suite 105, Boca Raton, Florida 33487, and the name of the initial Registered Agent of this corporation at that address is Arnold Y. Steinberg. 1. The manner and method in which and the persons by whom directors may be elected.


2. Any limitation upon the transferability or assignment of the stock.
