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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

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K.S. CONSULTING CORPORATION

ARTICLE I

Name and Address

The name of this corporation is K.S. CONSULTING CORPORATION, whose place of business is located at 1660 Gulf Boulevard, Penthouse 8, Clearwater, FL 34630.

ARTICLE II Duration

The term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

ARTICLE IV Capital Stock

This corporation is authorized to issue ONE THOUSAND (1,000) shares at One Dollar(s) (\$1.00) par value common stock, which shall be designated "common shares". At each election for directors, every shareholder entitled to vote at such elections shall have the right to cumulate his votes by giving one candidate as many votes as the number of directors to be elected at that time multiplied by the number of his shares, or by distributing such votes on the same principle among any number of such candidates.
