

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF



PAVEL_AMERICAN_CORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the Laws and Statutes of the State of Florida, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name of Corporation

The name by which this Corporation will be known, and under which it will conduct business shall be: PAVEL AMERICAN CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II

Term of Duration

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

Nature of Business

- A. The general nature of the business, proposed object, and/or purpose to be transacted, promoted, and/or carried on is to do any and all things; both as Principals and/or Agents, as hereinafter mentioned as fully and to the same effect and/or extent as natural persons and/or other Corporations might or could do.
- B. This Corporation may engage in any and all activities, businesses, and/or objects permitted under the Laws of the State of

Florida, said Corporation's primary purpose to be: IMPORT AND EXPORT BUSINESS.

- This Corporation may purchase, receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways acquire import, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise use, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, enjoy, make, borrow, guarantee, contract in respect of, trade and deal in, sell (whether wholesale or retail), exchange, mortgage, pledge, encumber, transfer, assign and in all other ways dispose of, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, place, cultivate, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal, or mixed, tangible, intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to money, credits, choses in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes on commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation (foreign or domestic) or of any government or subdivision, or agency thereof.
- D. To hire and employ agents, servants and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment, and to act as agent, contractor, principal or trustee.

- E. To promote or aid in any matter, financially or otherwise, any person, firm, association, or corporation, and to guaranty contracts and other obligations.
- F. To let concessions to others to do any of the things that this Corporation is empowered to do, and to enter into, make, perform and carry out, contracts and arrangements of every kind and character with any person, firm, association, or corporation, or any government or authority or subdivision or agency thereof.
- G. To do all and everything necessary, convenient or proper for the accomplishment or improvement of any and all of the business, purpose, or object of, or attaining to the business, purpose, or object of, or in furtherance of any and all of the powers enumerated in these ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION (including any and all AMENDMENTS thereto) or the BYLAWS, necessary or incidental to the protection or benefit of the Corporation as Principal, Agent, Director, Officer, Trustee, Legal Representative, or otherwise.

ARTICLE IV

Capitalization

The amount of capital with which this Corporation will begin business shall be 100 shares at \$10.00 par value.

This Corporation shall be authorized to issue any amount of additional Shares of Stock (Common and/or Preferred) when and for such consideration as may be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors at a meeting of the Board of Directors called for that purpose.

ARTICLE V

Directors

The business, purposes, and object of this Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors which shall be headed by a Chairman of the Board. The Director shall report directly to the Stockholders, and shall not be held accountable to anyone other than the Stockholders of this Corporation.


