The procedure for proposing and adopting amendments to these Articles of Incorporation shall be as provided by Florida Statutes, Chapter 607.


ARTICLE XIII

INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS


