ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
JUVENILE FIRESETTERS' EDUCATIONAL FUND, INC.

A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Juvenile Firesetters' Education Fund, Inc.

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Florida Department of State. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This corporation is being organized for the purpose of engaging in the transaction of any and all activities permitted under the laws of Florida and the United States of America.

ARTICLE IV. POWERS

This corporation may do and perform all such acts and things, including those generally allowed by the laws of Florida relative to corporations not for profit, as now existing, or as the law may henceforth provide, as from time to time may be necessary or expedient to the exercise of any and all of its corporate functions, powers, and rights.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

Any person who agrees to be bound by these Articles of Incorporation, the corporate ByLaws, and any rules and regulations which the Board of Directors may from time to time adopt, who completes a membership application form and submits it to the Board Of Directors, and who pays the applicable dues, is eligible and qualified for membership in this corporation. The corporate ByLaws may provide the Board Of Directors further discretionary powers relating to the admission of members.

ARTICLE VI. MANAGEMENT

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs and business conducted and managed by the Board Of Directors. Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board Of Directors, under any provision of the law, may be taken without a meeting, if all of the directors shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board of Directors. Any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors. Any certificate or other document filed, under any provision of the law which relates to the action so taken, shall state that the action was taken by the unanimous written consent of the Board Of Directors without a meeting, and that these Articles Of Incorporation authorize the Board Of Directors to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facia evidence of such authority.

ARTICLE VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation's initial Board of Directors shall have three (3) directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased, from time to time, by an amendment to the corporate Bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3).

The directors shall be elected annually by this corporation's members. The manner of the election of the directors shall be specified in the corporate Bylaws. The directors named herein, comprising the initial Board Of Directors, shall hold office until the election of directors at the first annual membership meeting.

The officers shall consist of a president, a vice president, a secretary, and a treasurer. This corporation may have such other officers as may be provided in the corporate Bylaws. 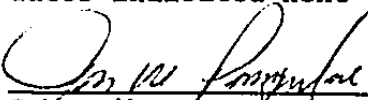
ARTICLE XII. BYLAWS

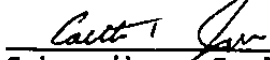
