The undersigned, acting as incorporator of this Corporation pursuant to Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby forms a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation shall be Electronic Printing Services, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE IX - INDEMNIFICATION

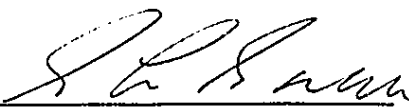
