

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator under the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is: **AWC FOOD SERVICES, INC.**

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation is being organized for the transaction of any and all lawful business permitted under the Florida General Corporation Act and the laws of the United States and the State of Florida. To engage in the business of owning and managing a restaurant and all other business lawful in the State of Florida.

To establish copy rights and/or patents, To purchase, to receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways import, lease possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise use, enjoy, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, make, borrow, guarantee, contract in respect of trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, hypothecate, encumber, transfer, assign and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market and in all other ways (whether like or unlike any of the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character,

real personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to, money, credits, choices in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, script, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government or subdivision of agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property, real property (improved or unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance thereto, including but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas and water rights, all or any part of any going business and its incidents, franchises, subsidies, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any government or subdivision or agency thereof, and any interest in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities of individual owners or holders thereof.

To hire and employ agents, servants and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment and collective bargaining agreements, and to act as agent, contractor, trustee, factor, or otherwise, either alone or in company with others.

To promote or aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, firm association or corporation, and to guarantee contracts and other obligations.

To let concessions to others to do any of the things that this

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of capital stock that the corporation is authorized to issue is FIVE HUNDRED (500) with one dollar (\$1.00) par value. All of the shares are of one class only.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V. ADDRESS
