## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MIAMI INVESTMENT ASSOCIATES, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be MIAMI INVESTMENT ASSOCIATES, INC. The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 100 S.E. 2nd Street, Suite 2750, Miami, Florida 33131.

#### ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

- (a) To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, lands and interest in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop and be erected, on any lands owned, held or occupied by the corporation, buildings or other structures, now or hereafter erected on any lands owned, held or occupied, and to encumber or dispose of any lands, or interest in lands, and any buildings or other structures, at any time owned or held by the corporations. - (c) To carry on in any capacity any business or trade deemed legal in the State of Florida.
- (d) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and to execute such mortgages, transfers or corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
- (e) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.
- (f) To become a partner with any person or persons, corporation, or any other business entity and engage in the same or other or any character of business legal in the State of Florida.

- (g) To guarantee, enderse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owners of such stock, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.
- (h) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts and agreements of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any firm, association, or corporation; and to transact any further and other business necessarily connected with the purposes of this corporation, or calculated to facilitate the same.
