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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

HARVEY C. FERBER, ARCHITECT, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of th): corporation shall be HARVEY C. FERBER, ARCHITECT, INC. hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business and objects and purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted and carried on are to do any and all things hereinafter mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, vis:

- services and all aspects thereof. To purchase or otherwise acquire and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise of every class, kind and description, necessary to the accomplishment of the above-stated business objectives, except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telegraph, telephone or cemetary company, a building and loan association, fraternal benefit society, mutual fire insurance association, cooperative, state fair or exposition.
- (b) To have one or more offices, conduct its business and promote its objects within and without the State of Florida, in other states, the District of Columbia, the territories, possessions and dependencies of the United States and in foreign countries, without restriction as to place or amount.

accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attaining of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers encumerated in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereof, necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the Corporation, as principale, agent, trustee, or otherwise, and, in general, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes or object of the corporation, whether or not such business is similar in nature to the purposes and objects set forth in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereof.

The foregoing paragraph—shall be construed as enumerating both—objects and powers of the Corporation; and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this Corporation.

This Corporation shall be entitled to all rights, powers and provisions of the laws of the State of Florida affecting corporations as such laws may now exist or as such laws may hereinatter be enaced.
