ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TERRELL ENTERPRISES, INC.

I, the undersigned, hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation shall be:

TERRELL ENTERPRISES, INC.

ARTICLE II

Existence of Corporation

This corporation shall begin existence on the 20th day February, 1996, and shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation and the general purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be sales and business management and to engage in any and all businesses and matters incidental to or connected with the foregoing in any manner or way whatsoever. Furthermore, the corporation may engage in the transaction of any or all lawful businesses for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

General Powers

The corporation shall have power:

- (a) To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at pleasure, and to use the same by causing it, or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed, affixed, or in any other manner reproduced.
- (o) To purchase, take, receive, lease, or otherwise, acquire, own, hold, improve, use and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.

- (c) To soll, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- (d) To lend money and extend credit all in accordance with Florida Statutes.
- (e) To purchase take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares of other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district, or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.
- (f) To make contract and guarantees and incur liabilities, bornew money at such pairs of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its poton, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, and income.
- (g) To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
- (h) To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this act within or outside this state.
- (i) To elect or appoint officers and agents of the corporation and define their duties and fix their compensation.
- (j) To make and alter bylaws, not inconsistent with its Articles of Incorporation or with the laws of the State of Florida, for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the corporation.
- (k) To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes.
- (1) To transact any lawful business which the Board of Directors shall find will be in aid of corporate policy.
- (m) To pay pensions and establish and carry out pension plans, profit sharing plans, stock bonus plans, stock option plans, retirement plans, benefit plans, and other incentive and compensation plans for any or all of the directors, officers and employees of its subsidiaries.
- (n) To provide insurance for its benefit on the life of any of its directory, officers, or employees, or on the life of any shareholder for the purpose of acquiring at his death shares of its

stock owned by the shareholder or by the spouse or children of the shareholder.

- (o) To be a promoter, incorporator, general partner, limited partner, member, associate, or manager of any corporation, partnership, limited partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise.
- (p) To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effects its purposes.

ARTICLE V

Capital Stock

(a) The total number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by the corporation shall be \$1,000 shares and have a par value of \$1.00 per share. Each of said shares of stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one (1) vote at any meeting of the stockholders. All or any part of said capital stock may be paid for in cash, in property or in labor of services actually performed for the corporation and valued at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for such purpose. All stock when issued shall be paid for and shall be nonassessable.

ARTICLE VI

Preemptive Rights

The stockholders of the corporation shall have the preemptive right to subscribe for and purchase their proportionate shares of any additional stock issued by the corporation, from and after the issuance of the shares originally subscribed for by the stockholders of this corporation, whether such additional shares be issued for cash, property, services or any other consideration, and whether or not such shares by presently authorized or be authorized by subsequent amendment to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE VII

Registered Office Principal Address and Registered Agent

The principal addr and the corporation's initial registered office address is 2941 Correll Circle, Lot #11, Mims, Florida 32754, and the name of the corporation's initial registered agent is JAMES E. TERRELL, 2941 Correll Circle, Lot #11, Mims, Florida 32754. The corporation may change its registered office or its registered agent or both by filing with the Department of State of the State of Florida a statement complying with Section 607.037, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VIII

Initial Board of Directors

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be one (1), and the name and address of the person who is to serve as the member thereof is as follows:

ARTICLE IX

Amendment of Articles of Incorporation

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon the stockholders herein are subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE X

Indemnification

The Corporation shall indemnify, or advance reasonable expenses, to the fullest extent authorized or permitted by the Florida General Corporation Act, any person made, or threatened to be made, a party to any action, suit or proceeding by reason of the fact that he/she (i) is or was a director of the Corporation; (ii) is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director of another corporation; (iii) is or was an officer of the Corporation, provided that he is or was at the time a director of the Corporation or a director of such other corporation, serving at the request of the Corporation. Unless otherwise expressly prohibited by the Florida General Corporation Act, and except as otherwise provided in the foregoing sentence, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the sole and exclusive discretion, on such terms and conditions as it shall determine, to indemnify, or advance expenses to, any person made, or threatened to be made, a party to any action, suit, or proceeding by reason of the fact that he/she is or was an officer, employee or agent of the Corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as an officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise. No person falling within the purview of the foregoing sentence may apply for indemnification or advancement of expenses to any court of competent jurisdiction.
