ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

CONCORDE - 56TH STREET, INC.

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the corporation is CONCORDE - 56TH STREET, INC., and its principal business address is 12954 North Dale Mabry Highway, Tampa, Florida 33618.

Duration
