ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE BUSINESS SUCCESS GROUP, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of F.S. Chapter 607, the undersigned being natural persons, do hereby act as incorporators in adopting and filing the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing a business corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: THE BUSINESS SUCCESS GROUP, INC.

ARTICLE II

The address of the principal office of the corporation is 124 S.W. 24 Road, Miami, Florida 33129.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The general purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act or engage in any other trade or business which can, in the opinion of the board of directors of the corporation, be advantageously carried on in connection with

been heretofore or hereafter taken or omitted by him as such director or officer and shall reimburse each such person for all legal and other expenses reasonably incurred by him in connection with any such claim or liability provided that no person shall be indemnified against or be reimbursed for any expenses incurred in connection with any claim or liability as to which it shall be adjudged that such officer or director is liable for negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his duties.

The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provisions shall not exclude any other right to which he may be lawfully entitled nor shall anything therein contained restrict the right of the corporation to indemnify and reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically herein provided for.

No contract or other transaction between this corporation and any other corporation, and no act of this corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of the corporation are peculiarly or otherwise interested in or are directors or officers of such other corporation, any director, individually or any firm of which any director may be a member, may be a party to, or may be peculiarly or otherwise interested in, any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided that the fact that the firm so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors or such Liembers thereof as shall be present at any meeting of the Board of Directors at which action upon any such contract or transaction shall be taken, and any director of the corporation or is so interested may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize any such contract or transaction, with the like force and effect as if he were not such director or officer of such other corporation or not so interested.
