ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is **ANGELA CHRISTANNE TRULUCK, P.A.**

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing on the date of signing.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business, including that of a Real Estate Associate.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 7,500 shares of no par value common stock.

ARTICLE V - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

ARTICLE VIII - INCORPORATOR

This corporation shall have all of the corporate powers as those enumerated in the Florida Statute covering Professional Associations, as well as the power to act as Trustee.
