ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is:

American Transactions Corp.

ARTICLE II. - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

a) To engage and conduct in any business which is authorized and permitted by the Laws of the State of Florida. Particularly,

The sale and servicing of on-line databases and information networks.
