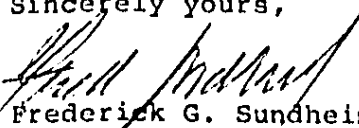

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ST. LUCIE WEB DEVELOPMENT, INC.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be ST. LUCIE WEB DEVELOPMENT, INC.

ARTICLE II. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the businesses to be transacted by this corporation is to develop and provide web pages for the computer industry and all related lawful businesses.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 1,000 having a nominal or par value of one (\$1.00) dollar per share.

ARTICLE V. REGISTERED OFFICE

ARTICLE VIII. BY-LAWS

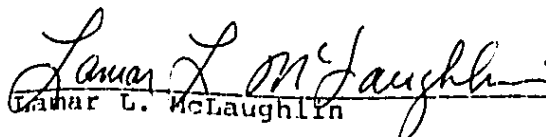
The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal By-Laws shall be vested in the Shareholders.

ARTICLE X. PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

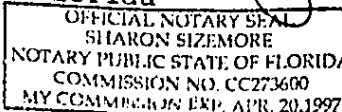

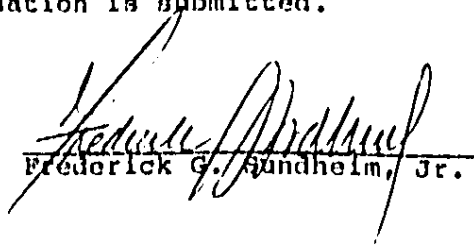
