## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FILE STATES

The undersigned subscriber to these Artionascian STATE Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

The name of the corporation shall be Tampa Bay Family Magazine, Inc.
