ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

OLD CITY PROPERTIES, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME and PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of this corporation is OLD CITY PROPERTIES, INC. and its principal place of business shall be located at 225 West King Street, St. Augustine, Florida 32084.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of the Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE
