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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
LOWERY, INC.

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ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is Lowery, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of owning, operating and maintaining a business establishment, and otherwise serving the convenience of its shareholders, by providing a restaurant and food supply service, and all other lawful businesses.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 1000 shares of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) par value common stock.


ARTICLE X - BY-LAWS
