Dear Sir or Madam,

In September 2006, the above mentioned company with Docket # P9600038375 was reinstated improperly. The intention was not to claim any right to the corporation in any shape or form. The intention was to simply secure the name Vision Twenty-One for a new business venture and instead of incorporating a new entity with the same name, an already dissolved corporation was reinstated by mistake.

Since the improper reinstatement, there has been absolutely no business conducted in any shape or form under this company or under any entity bearing a similar name at all. The proposed business venture did not materialize after the reinstatement and it was later realized that the company was reinstated instead of simply being reincorporated.

As per our conversation and instructions from the Division of Corporations at the Florida Department of State, we are filing Articles of Dissolution to reverse the reinstatement process and return the company back to its "Dissolved" state. Since the Articles of Dissolution require that it be completed in its entirety, we had no choice but to complete the appropriate articles to the best of our knowledge to cause the Articles of Dissolution to be declared effective immediately as explained below.

## Article 4 states that "None of the corporation's have been issued".

This box was checked assuming that the original company officers and directors, had previously issued shares in this corporation and therefore we checked the appropriate box. Another factor was the fact that the company was or is a publicly traded company trading in the United States and such status clearly indicates that shares must have been issued.

## Article 7 states that "A majority of the incorporator's authorized the dissolution."

We checked this box as it best applied to the situation. As per the request of the company's legal counsel in Tampa, Florida, we agreed to dissolve the company and return it back to its state prior to its accidental reinstatement.

Kindly accept this letter of explanation regarding this situation. We request that this letter be filed along with the Articles of Dissolution and be available for viewing by all parties.
