ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - MANE OF CORPORATION AND BUSINESS ADDRESS

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date filed with Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation is as follows:

To operate a medical magazine; and to do any and all things and matters necessary and appertaining thereto and further enabling this corporation to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Plorida. Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

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If a quorum is prosent, the affirmative vote of 51% of the shares represented at the maeting and entitled to vote on the subject matter shall be the act of the shareholders.

The corporation shall indemnify any officers and directors, and former officers and directors, to the full extent permitted by law as the law now exists or may be amended hersefter.
