ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of the MALLAHASLES, FLORIDA Incorporation hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is RAM Steel, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Term of Existence

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

- h. To make contracts and guaranties and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bond, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises and income.
