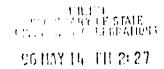

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### OF

### ON LINE SEAFOOD, INC.

The undersigned, being an individual, does hereby act as incorporator in adopting the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing a corporation for profit, pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act.

**FIRST:** The corporate name for the corporation (hereinafter called the "corporation") is ON LINE SEAFOOD, INC.

**SECOND:** The address, wherever located, of the principal office of the corporation, if known, is 10250 Caribbean Blvd., Miami, Florida 33189.

**THIRD:** The mailing address, wherever located, of the corporation is 10250 Caribbean Blvd., Miami, Florida 33189.

**FOURTH:** The number of shares that the corporation is authorized to issue is two hundred, all of which are without par value and are of the same class and are to be Common shares.
