*Articles of Incorporation of*  
**ERIC J. DORER, P.A.**  
A Professional Corporation

The undersigned natural person, competent and licensed to practice law in the State of Florida, acting hereby as Incorporator for the purpose of forming a Professional Service Corporation for profit under the provisions of Chapter 607, Florida General Corporation Act, and Chapter 621, Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, of the Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE ONE**

Name

The name of this corporation shall be ERIC J. DORER, P.A.

**ARTICLE TWO**

Purposes

The general nature and purposes of business to be transacted, promoted and carried on by the corporation are as follows:

- (a) To engage in every aspect in the practice of law, and all its fields of specialization, as are engaged in by attorneys and counselors at law.
- (b) To engage in and render the professional services involved only through its officers, agents and employees who shall be attorneys and counselors at law in good standing and duly licensed and legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional services as this corporation.
- (c) To invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds and any other type of investments permitted by law.

(d) To engage in no other business than the rendition of the professional services specified herein.

(e) To do everything necessary and proper in accomplishing the purposes herein set forth and to do anything incidental thereto which is not forbidden under the laws of the State of Florida.

### **ARTICLE THREE**

#### **Capital Stock**

(a) The maximum number of shares of stock that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock at One Dollar (\$1.00) per share par value.

(b) The consideration to be paid for each share shall be payable in lawful money or property, labor or services.

(c) Shares of the corporation's stock and certificates shall be issued only to attorneys at law in good standing who are duly licensed and legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional services as this corporation.

### **ARTICLE FOUR**

#### **Duration**

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### **ARTICLE FIVE**

#### **Principal Office Address/Registered Agent**

The address of this corporation's principal office is 412 Northeast Fourth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301-1152, and the name of its registered agent at said address is ERIC J. DORER, Attorney and Counselor at Law.

**ARTICLE SIX**

**Incorporator**

The name and address of the Incorporator is as follows: ERIC J. DORER, ESQUIRE, 412 Northeast Fourth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301-1152.

**ARTICLE SEVEN**

**Board of Directors**

The corporation shall have a Board of Directors consisting of one person. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by resolution of the majority of the Stockholders but shall never be less than one. The name and address of the initial Director of this corporation is ERIC J. DORER, ESQUIRE, 412 Northeast Fourth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301-1152.

**ARTICLE EIGHT**

**Informal Shareholder Action**

Any action of the Shareholders may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing setting forth the action so taken shall be signed by all the Shareholders entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and and filed with the Secretary of the corporation as part of the corporate records.

**ARTICLE NINE**

**Disqualification of Stockholder, etc.**

If any officer, director, stockholder, agent or employee of this corporation becomes legally disqualified to render the professional services for which the corporation is organized, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on his continued rendering of such professional services, he shall forthwith sever all employment with the corporation, and shall not thereafter participate or share, directly or indirectly, in any earnings or profits realized by the corporation on account of professional services. The

corporation shall forthwith, upon such disqualification of any shareholder, purchase such shareholder's shares and pay him all amounts owing and lawfully due to him by the corporation, except that such shares shall not be entitled to dividends.

**ARTICLE TEN**  
Informal Director Action

If all of the Directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the Secretary of the corporation, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.

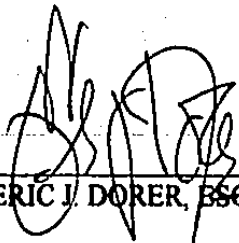
**ARTICLE ELEVEN**

**ARTICLE TWELVE**  
Bylaw Amendment

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the bylaws of this corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors and Stockholders provided that such amendment be in compliance with the laws of Florida governing a Professional Service Corporation.

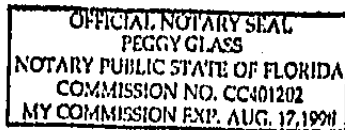
