We are writing to inform you that the notice of Dissolution/Revocation was the first notice that we ever received from your office. No other notices were ever received.

When we moved our offices to a private residence, we submitted a Change of Address form to the Post Office. Two weeks went by and no mail was delivered. We contacted the Post Office and we were informed that it sometimes takes ten days to two weeks before the mail "catches up" with us.

In an effort to locate some of our mail, we went back to our old address, which was vacant, and found the outside mailbox contained damaged, wet mail. We again reported this to the Post Office. It was almost three weeks before our forwarded mail began to arrive at our new address. Shortly thereafter, we began receiving call and notices from some of our creditors regarding unpaid bills. It appears that during the mail transfer, some of our mail was lost. During this same period of time, our neighbors were bringing us some of our mail that had been delivered to their house in error. We again contacted the Post Office.

After again complaining to the Postperson, he said he would make sure it didn't happen again. The problem continued until a supervisor was contacted at the Post Office. Now the excuse was that the postperson could not find the mailbox. We explained that the mailbox could clearly be seen from the street and that it had been in its present location for years. He said to solve the problem, we should put a mailbox at the street. I have attached a copy of the mailbox instructions that the Post Office gave us.

In conclusion, we feel that we are being unfairly penalized for a situation that was beyond our control. You are welcome to contact the supervisor, who's name is Bob, at 800-670-0855 and he will verify that this problem existed.

Our corporation has a AAA-1 credit rating and would never allow our corporation status to be in jeopardy.

We are also attaching our Application for Reinstatement and our application fee in the amount of \$165.00.
